

US Army Corps of Engineers Section 404 Permit Closeout

Once construction is complete on Emergency Watershed Protection (EWP) flood recovery projects, local project sponsors must closeout the Section 404 Nationwide Permit from the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) by returning the *Certification of Completed Work*. The form must be submitted to the USACE when construction is complete within the ordinary high water mark and wetlands areas of the project site.

Certification of Completed Work

Local project sponsors must complete and return the *Certification of Completed Work* (blue form) that was included with the Nationwide Permit Verification Letter received in the mail from the USACE. The form is also attached on the second page of this document.

To complete the form, fill in the following information found in the National Permit Verification Letter:

- **USACE File Number** This number is located in the subject line of the letter and starts with "NWO-".
- > Name of Permittee This is the local project sponsor contact name.
- Date of Issuance The date of the letter from the USACE.
- Expiration Date The date listed in the letter as "this verification will be valid until ____".
- > Signature of Permittee Signature of the local project sponsor contact.
